
There is 1 Assignment for Stage – III, i.e. C.3.1., is Compulsory Subject.

3. Explain, in brief, the composition and functions of the Delhi Urban Arts Commission (DUAC) set up under the Delhi Urban Arts Commission Act, 1973 and evaluate its effectiveness in preserving developing and maintaining the aesthetic quality of urban and environmental design in Delhi.
4. Briefly discuss the concept and meaning of public purpose as evolved in the newly enacted Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 by replacing the old Land Acquisition Act, 1894. Does the new land acquisition Act response to the requirements of urban land acquisition? Give reasons in support of your answer.
